

Dog CPR Flowchart

Check for breathing for 10 seconds

Call for help if available

- Open airway
- Check for normal breathing for no more than 10 seconds
- Call for help and get someone to call your vet if possible

Deliver 5 initial rescue breaths

Deliver 30 chest compressins

Deliver 2 rescue breaths

Continue CPR 30:2

- Open airway, pull the tounge to one side and seal the mouth. Deliver 5 rescue breaths until you see the chest rise by blowing in the nose
- Deliver 30 compressions in centre of chest at a rate of 100-120 compressions per minute to a depth of at least one third the depth of the chest with one hand
- Then open the airway and deliver 2 breaths until you see the chest rise
- Repeat at 30 compressions and 2 breaths

Continue until they start to breath

• Continue until they start to breath, you are too tired to continue, someone else takes over or the vet arrives.

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
